

Rooftop Sauna A cold Canadian winter is enough to make anyone crave a good schvitz, so when Toronto dentist Kenneth Montague cut a deal to have the roof of the building his flat is in to himself, he set his architect David Anand Peterson to work on a sauna. Custom built from Douglas fir and cedar, and clad in Kota black limestone, the sauna still manages a nod to Montague's home below. "We wanted to create a sense of aesthetic continuity with other parts of the home," said Peterson, "so we used an Indian limestone for the wash-room floor and wall and also in the kitchen and on the terrace."

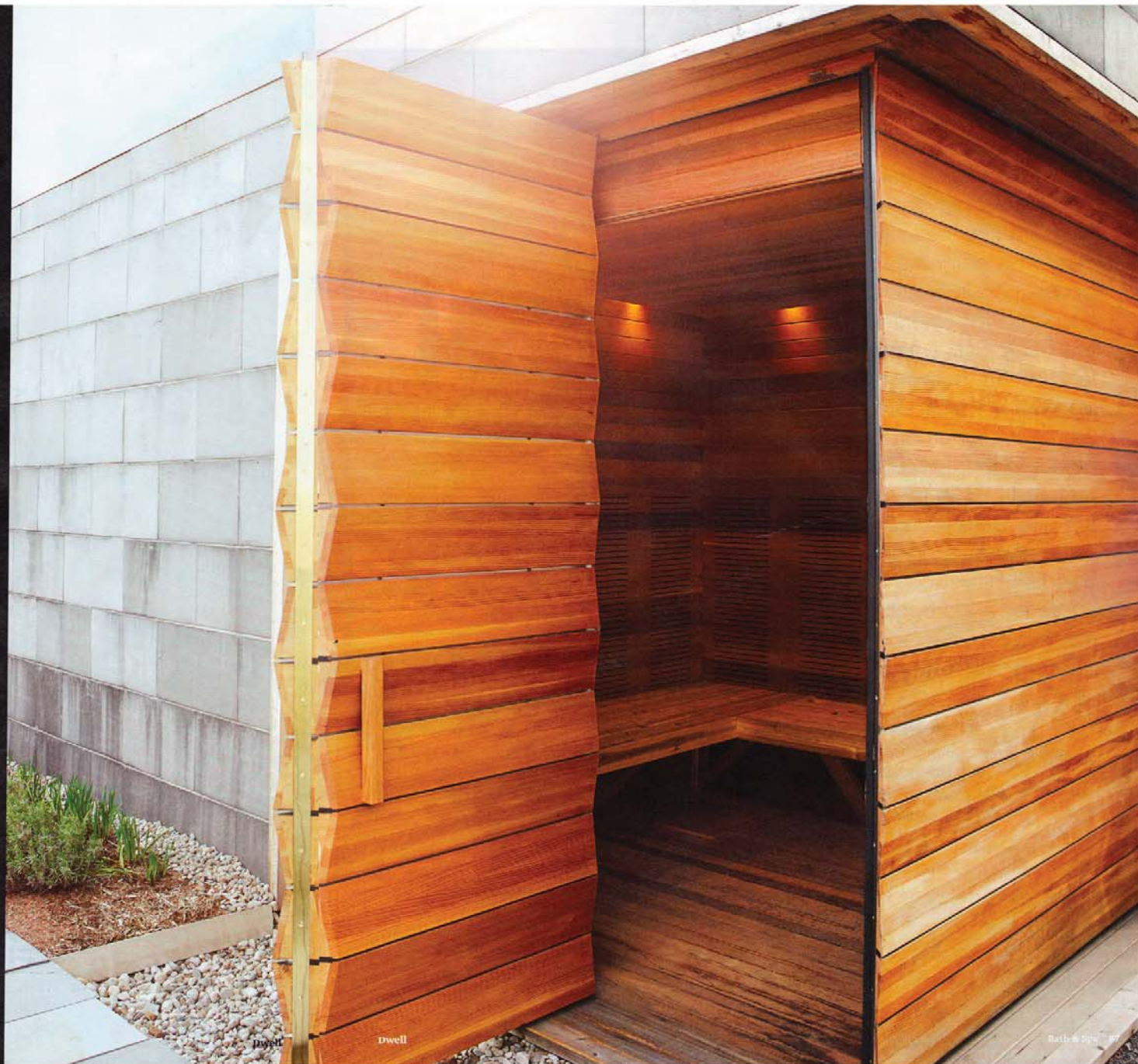
